The **IU Bloomington Office of Sorority and Fraternity Life** receives budget support from two sources: the Office of Student Life and the Greek Fee. The Greek Fee is assessed to all members of sororities and fraternities. During the 2022-2023 academic year, the fee was \$40 per semester for Interfraternity Council/Panhellenic Association members and \$25 per semester for Multicultural Greek Council/National Pan-Hellenic Council members. During the 2023-2024 academic year, the fee has increased to \$50 per semester for Interfraternity Council/Panhellenic Association members and \$30 per semester for Multicultural Greek Council/National Pan-Hellenic Council members. During the 2023-2024 academic year, the fee has increased to \$50 per semester for Interfraternity Council/Panhellenic Association members and \$30 per semester for Multicultural Greek Council/National Pan-Hellenic Council members. The Greek Fee is an important component of ensuring the IU sorority and fraternity community has staff support, educational programs, leadership development, and assessment efforts to meet the community standards and values.
